Marshfield Clinic Health System serves the Stevens Point area through one medical center, a cancer center and two primary and specialty care locations. Marshfield Medical Center-River Region at Stevens Point includes a 12-bed hospital. The medical center provides 24/7 emergency department coverage along with adult and pediatric primary care, urgent care, emergency transportation, an inpatient unit, imaging and lab services, pharmacy, physical and occupational therapy.

The Health System's network of care in the region includes a primary and specialty clinic in Wisconsin Rapids and a behavioral health clinic in Plover.
