\**Subspecialty rotations* at Marshfield Clinic are primarily outpatient experiences; however, residents also participate in hospital consults during their subspecialty rotations.

\*\*Marshfield Clinic residents complete their Pediatric ER rotation at Milwaukee Children's. Our program pays for resident housing in Milwaukee during this required offsite rotation.

\*\*The American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) requires all pediatric residents to complete 36 months of training and allows a *maximum* of 4 weeks of time away from training each year. Additional time away (for maternity leave for example) *may* be 'waived' if residents are deemed competent in their final year of training. Time missed from ACGME *required* rotations cannot be waived.
