- 3. Aim to improve health of marginalized or underserved populations such as seniors, veterans, low income, etc.

C4C Funding Categories

1. Rural Healthcare Access and Quality
Assuring communities are empowered,
educated and have access to affordable,
high-quality, and timely healthcare
services.

2. Rural Healthcare Workforce and Education

Growing the healthcare and public health workforce is fundamental in meeting the evolving and growing health needs of the community.

3. Community Health Improvements

Addressing community health needs are important to MCHS and our communities. Our community health areas of focus are:

- behavioral health
- substance use
- health equity
- public health capacity and infrastructure.



Timelines

- 1. Requests for Community Investment Funding must be made at least 60 days in advance.
- 2. MCHS will make our best effort to notify applicants by the 15th of the month after the month in which the application was submitted.
- 3. Applications that are incomplete or not thoroughly described will not be reviewed.
- 4. Additional time may be needed to process any funding will be dependent on an applicant providing any necessary or additional information or paperwork in a timely manner.

Eligibility

MCHS will not consider requests for the following:

- 1. For-profit organizations
- 2. Political or religious organizations
- 3. Organizations from outside the MCHS service area
- 4. Individuals requesting personal funds or for funding to benefit a specific individual or family
- 5. Capital expenses
